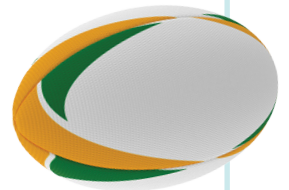

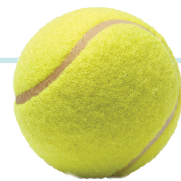
### Arin watching rugby at the park

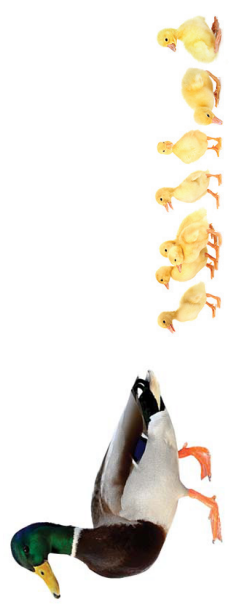
